

**LADY CRUISERS OF THE OZARKS**  
**MINUTES OF MONTHLY MEETING**

**FEBRUARY, 2009**

The meeting was brought to order by Director Deana Foster around 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, February 21, 2009, at the Library Center on South Campbell in Springfield, Missouri.
